

Environmental protection in the OT Port Gdynia

OT Port Gdynia, part of the OT Logistics Capital Group, is not indifferent to global challenges concerning the protection of the environment and its resources. As one of the most universal port terminals in Poland, it contributes to reducing the adverse impact of business on the environment. Within the scope of its operations, it strives to protect the environment by setting goals aimed at its care. It reduces and eliminates factors detrimental to the environment, both in the course of day-to-day operations and in long-term projects. OT Port Gdynia strives to be an increasingly ecological transshipment terminal, implementing the so-called "green" development strategy. Actions that it currently conducts are the introduction of eco-friendly solutions in the area of administration and infrastructure. In the offices, a modern and ecological function of trailing printout has been introduced, which allows for a significant reduction in paper consumption and a real change in printing habits. Printing is now only possible after entering your printer password. At the same time, double-sided and black-and-white printing has been introduced in the settings of copying devices. These measures have visibly reduced the company's paper consumption. OT Port Gdynia strives to reduce electricity consumption and rational use of raw materials, following the implementation of procedures to reduce greenhouse gas emissions by reducing electricity consumption through improving energy efficiency, by modernizing lighting in the properties - which is the result of an energy audit conducted in accordance with the PNEN 16247 standard, which accurately shows the feasibility of applying solutions to improve energy efficiency in the properties. In the buildings, lighting is gradually replaced with energy-saving bulbs and LEDs, and automatic light switches are introduced. The company does not forget about waste reduction and its proper segregation by placing appropriately marked containers for selective waste. What is more, it promotes among customers the digitalization of information and document flow, such as electronic invoice circulation (e-Invoice) or electronic service announcement systems. Handling equipment and machines are successively modified and replaced with modern, more efficient and environmentally friendly ones. The terminal implements all procedures and proceedings according to environmental laws and regulations and all other environmental requirements.

Energy saving is one of the top environmental priorities of the entire Group. The company is aware not only of the negative impact of wasted electricity on the environment, but also of the potential financial benefits achievable through a frugal energy policy. OT Logistics Capital Group has decided to prepare and implement a common environmental policy for the entire organization, so that its development will take place taking into account its impact on the environment and respecting its resources.
